From the north: Proceed south on Route 29 (Emmet Street) through several traffic lights. Drive under the Routes 29/250 bypass (an overpass), stay on Route 29 Business for 1.7 miles. From the overpass continue straight through 3 traffic lights and you will see the Cavalier Inn on your right just before reaching the 4th traffic light at the intersection of Route 29 Business (Emmet St.) and Ivy Rd.

From the east, west and south: From I-64, take Exit 118B. Take 2nd exit off the 250/29 bypass. Turn right on to Route 250 business east. You will see the Cavalier Inn on your left as you approach the 3rd traffic light. At the intersection of Route 29 Business (Emmet St.) and Ivy Road.
